THE FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME JULY 3, 2022



Along with countless people, I felt great relief when I heard on Sunday that the majority of the body of Parker Kruse had been recovered. As much as it doesn't alleviate the pain of losing one of the young people of our community, nonetheless, especially for his family and friends, it will be a big part of the grieving process and hopefully healing as well.

But why do we, especially as Catholics, place such emphasis on honoring the bodies of those who have died? If the eternal soul has departed, what is the point?

The body is essential to the very being of a human person. At death the separation of the soul from the body is an abnormality of human existence. We were created to be a soul *and* a body. We are

not simply some spirit imprisoned in a body. Our body is not a discardable container of the soul. The fact that the soul separates from the body at death is the result of original sin; such separation is not the intention of creation.

Body and soul cannot be separated as if one is more important than the other in terms of what it means to be a human person. The body of the deceased is the same body that was consecrated to Christ in baptism, was a temple of the Holy Spirit through confirmation, received the Body of Christ in the Eucharist, was the means of expression of marital love, etc.

At death we treat the body with respect because it is essential to the person who has died and is the body that will be resurrected on the last day.

This informs the preference that the Church has for having the body present at the Funeral Mass, even if it will be cremated eventually before burial. This is also why caskets are incensed at the Funeral Mass, representing our prayers rising up to the Lord on their behalf.

So from the very moment of our conception, we are given not only a body, but that priceless gift of a unique and unrepeatable soul, that has a great journey ahead of it, ending gloriously with Resurrection, like Christ the Lord, and communion with God our creator.


