

# THE SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME JANUARY 14, 2024



Dear Friends in Christ.

This Sunday we will open up voting for our parish name. A new name is a big decision, but I trust that the Holy Spirit is at work in

our process. More than a few of you have said it's difficult to pick one of these names! With the assistance of the *Into the Deep* Transition Team, I have given you six names to consider. In correspondence with me, there was no other name which received significant attention to merit being placed on the ballot. You may, however, still write in a different parish name on the ballot.

The vote will be tallied and presented as a consultative piece of information for the Transition Team. You may cast two votes for one name or split your votes between two names. The ballot will be clear. There will be no online ballot, only in person voting between January 13-28.

Our Transition Team will discuss the results at our 6 pm meeting on January 30th at St Luke's. Thank you for praying and putting some time into our naming process!

### Other Notes:

This past week, I made a pilgrimage to the Oratory of St. Joseph in Montreal. I prayed very much for my own conversion and the conversion of all of you. St. John Paul said we should be in a constant state of conversion. We must continually turn a way from sin, repent and turn back to God. This is our daily bread, our constant struggle! It's a joyful struggle which, yes, can also be difficult and feel like spiritual warfare. Our God never looses any battles...and we are victorious so long as we keep trying and never give up. Here are a couple of powerful catechism paragraphs about conversion and spiritual battle to consider:

1989 ~ The first work of the grace of the Holy Spirit is conversion, effecting justification in accordance with Jesus' proclamation at the beginning of the Gospel: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." Moved by grace, man turns toward God and away from sin, thus accepting forgiveness and righteousness from on high. "Justification is not only the remission of sins, but also the sanctification and renewal of the interior man.

2015 ~ The way of perfection passes by way of the Cross. There is no holiness without renunciation and spiritual battle. Spiritual progress entails the ascesis and mortification that gradually lead to living in the peace and joy of the Beatitudes:

He who climbs never stops going from beginning to beginning, through beginnings that have no end. He never stops desiring what he already knows.






