

Dear Friends in Christ.

from the As we begin the new year, I have some Paster important and exciting news which affects our worship schedule beginning in February.

A project which has been in the works for some time is coming to fruition: the complete refinishing of the **original** St. Luke pews (including choir and cry room), the installation of new kneelers on these pews and the polishing and resealing of the original terrazzo floor. The pews will be removed on January 29th and taken to a workshop in St. Paul, MN for stripping and refinishing. While the pews are gone, the terrazzo company will work in the Church on the stripping and polishing of the floor. Because St. Luke Church has over 1,000 linear feet of pews, the project is quite lengthy (literally) ~ the pews won't be back until late April. The funds for this project will come from previous generous bequests made specifically to the "pew refurbishing fund," memorials left to St. Luke's which are restricted for church maintenance and any new donations that people may wish to make!

I will certainly miss St. Luke's during this 12-week closure! I see this moment, however, as an opportunity for those who usually worship at St. Luke to attend Mass at St. John's or St. Pat's and continue to build our parish unity. In the near future, I anticipate St. John's to be closed for a flooring project--if so, parishioners who usually worship at St. John's would be asked to attend St. Luke's or St. Pat's. Taking care of our buildings, especially our churches, reflects our love for God and our desire to give him a beautiful home. I consider myself very blessed to have beautiful churches to work in and serve our good God.

During the months of February, March, and April, we will reduce our Sunday Mass schedule to four masses. Regarding the collection, there will be a system in place so that St. Luke's still receives some cash offertory. I will discuss this with the finance councils later this month. St. Luke's parishioners will be encouraged to use St. Luke's envelopes at St. Pat's and St. John's. Ushers, lectors and sacristans from St. Luke will also be encouraged to help out at St. John's Masses.

During the closure at St. Luke, we will set up a temporary altar in the Church hall for Tuesday evening (5:15 p.m.) and Wednesday mid-morning (10:45 a.m.) daily Masses. All other daily Masses will be moved to St. John's.

Other Notes:

Please note the date of Easter is quite early this year: March 31st. Ash Wednesday is on February 14th. The Sacred Paschal Triduum will be celebrated at St. John (March 28-March 30).

- Our new website is up and running with more pages being filled out each week! One nice feature is that payments or donations are securely accepted on the site. Just look for the "giving" tab.
- Our day of prayer/adoration at St. John's went very well on December 28th. We look forward to offering more times for Adoration and extended times for confession during Lent.
- Please keep our second graders in your prayers as they prepare for their first confession on Wednesday Jan. 10th, 6:00 p.m. at St. John.
- Sunday, January 7, 2024, is the Feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, one of the oldest of all Christian feasts. It is also known as Three Kings' Day. It commemorates the visit of the Magi to the Christ Child.
- If you would like to mark your doors with the traditional Epiphany inscription (see below) there is blessed chalk in the back of the church you may take. You may save the chalk or break it up into small pieces and scatter it on the ground to dispose of it after completing the inscription:

20 + C + M + B + 24

"In this year of Our Lord, 2024, may all who enter this house from the North (draw +), South (+), East (+) and West (+)

walk in the footsteps of the wise men Caspar (C), Melchior (M) and Balthazar (B). "

- "20" and "24" stand for the new year (2024), of course. The plus signs represent the Cross. CMB are the first initials of the traditional names given to the Magi ~ Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar. They also abbreviate the Latin Christus mansionem benedicat, or "May Christ bless the house."
- I encourage you to pray the Rosary in your homes. I find that there is a sense of peace in homes where the Rosary is prayed. The evil spirits flee from places where Our Lady and her Son are honored and loved!






