From the Partor

Dear Friends in Christ,

The second week of Lent sets before us a scripture reading which will come up again

at the Easter Vigil: The story of Abraham and Isaac. This is a signal to us that Lent is a season of preparation for Holy Week, culminating in the great Vigil ("The Mother of all Vigils") on Holy Saturday night. When we are struggling with our Lenten resolutions, we do well to think of praying and singing at the Easter Vigil! Our fasting, prayer and almsgiving will make enjoyable the banquet of Easter.

In the story of Abraham and Isaac scholars have noted that Isaac is the one who carries the heavier load up the hill, the wood for the sacrifice. This means Isaac is not a weak boy but rather fully capable of resisting the sacrifice that his Father is asked to make. Isaac, the beloved Son, is a foreshadowing of Jesus, the beloved only-begotten Son of the Father. They are both willing participants in their own sacrifice. Jesus is clear in the Gospel of John that he is the one that lays down his own life (see John 10:17-18).

Sacrifice is the engine which drives goodness forward in this world. Or, as Pope Benedict once said, "The World runs off sacrifice." May the Lord grant us the ability to sacrifice ourselves, to never feel like the victim and find joy in being chosen by God to offer sacrifices both small and large.


