

# THE HOLY FAMILY OF JESUS, MARY, AND JOSEPH DECEMBER 31, 2023



Dear Friends in Christ,

The Savior is born for us! Christmas is a time to start out afresh, especially in our friendships and relationships. Life is too short to hold on to grudges and resentments--these will eat away at our interior peace. Before the Christ Child

we should ask for the holy simplicity and openness of children. It takes courage to reach out, to offer forgiveness--it takes the holy boldness that only God can give us.

Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn once wrote:

"The line separating good and evil passes not through states, nor between classes, nor between political parties either -- but right through every human heart -- and through all human hearts. This line shifts. Inside us, it oscillates with the years. And even within hearts overwhelmed by evil, one small bridgehead of good is retained"

In our world it becomes easy to "cancel" others--to throw them completely out of our life. Sometimes it is true that we cannot be reconciled to others, yet, we always must offer them, at least, forgiveness from our own hearts. This time of year I would encourage us to try to see the "small bridgehead of good" even in those from whom we are separated because of some hurt or resentment. This is what Christ instructed us to do in his preaching: "love your enemies." This doesn't mean we enable evildoers, but it means we try to put out evil in an abundance of good. Christmas is about seeing, in the flesh, an abundance of goodness and love in the Holy Infant.

The Christmas decorations and celebrations were all so very well done. Thank you to the choir, ushers, servers, decorators and so many more! We gave Glory to God in the Highest!

Our first transition team meeting was on December 21st. We had a good discussion about the future name of our parish. As we set out "Into the Deep," one of the tasks we need to accomplish is to present the Bishop with three options for the future name of our parish. Before getting too far ahead please read these brief reminders on names:

- 1.) All Church buildings, as long as they remain standing, will retain their name forever.
- 2.) The schools will retain their same name. In the case of a school merger, the schools would likely take on the name of the new parish.3.) The new name is very important because it becomes our new identity as a single parish. (Pastorate 6 is only a temporary name!)

At our transition team meeting we decided to present to the parish five names for your consideration. The five names which we decided upon, in no particular order, are:

- 1.) Mary Mother of God
- 2.) St. Anne
- 3.) Divine Child
- 4.) Good Shepherd
- 5.) St. Maximillian Kolbe

After looking over the names I have also realized the need to add a 6th option: 6.) Saints Joachim and Anne

Since the 2nd Vatican Council, Joachim and Anne have shared the feast day of July 26th. Thus it would only be appropriate to also consider naming our parish under both of their names.

We looked for a name which was welcoming, encompassing and with a certain ease to spell and market. As a team these names also came to us through our own prayer and reflection on the Into the Deep merger process. We have on this list a female saint (from the early church), a male saint (from the most recent century), two titles for Our Lord Jesus and one title for Mary. If you have another name in mind which you feel we should consider you may send me an e-mail with a short explanation. I will consider adding the name to our poll, which will be sent out on 1/14, if I receive a few notes about a similar name or if one strikes me as particularly appropriate for us. Over the next two weeks I will be publishing some further explanations of these names.

Here is our timeline for the naming process:

- a. Sundays  $12/31/23 \& 1/7/24 \sim$  presentation of 5 names to parishioners
- b. Sunday 1/14/24 ~ Voting begins (on-line & paper ballot in back of church-- an option for write in names will be included)
- c. Sunday  $1/28/24 \sim \text{Last day for voting}$
- d. Tuesday  $1/30/24 \sim$  Transition Team uses voting results to help narrow the list down to 3 names
- e. Thursday 2/15/24 ~ 3 names due to Bishop Donald Hying.
- f. Bishop Hying will give us our new name before July 1st, 2024.






